HEPATITIS A is a highly contagious liver infection caused by a virus passed from person to person.

Symptoms of Hepatitis A:



Fever



Fatigue



Nausea



Loss of appetite



Jaundice (yellowing of the skin or eyes)



Stomach pain



Vomiting



Dark urine, pale stools, and diarrhea

To Prevent infection:

- Get two shots of hepatitis A vaccine
- Don't have sex with an infected person
- Use your own towels, toothbrush & utensils
- Don't share food, drinks, or smokes
- Wash hands with soap and water after using the bathroom, and before preparing, serving or eating food

Para prevenir la infección:

- Recibir dos dosis de la vacuna contra hepatitis A
- No tener relaciones sexuales con alguien que este infectado con hepatitis A
- No compartir comida, bebidas o cigarrillos
- Lavarse las manos con agua y jabón después de usar el baño y antes de preparar, servir o comer alimentos
